



# Landowner Program

**Bundaberg Regional Council has a vision of planting one million trees in the Bundaberg region by the end of 2024.**

The Landowner Program will allow property owners to nominate land within the Bundaberg Regional Council area on which trees can be planted. Council staff will work with Landowners to select suitable native tree species for their property.

To be part of the Landholder Program you need to have:

- An adequate amount of land for development of trees to grow to maturity
- The ability to undertake land preparation and seedling planting
- Capacity to maintain and care for the trees (e.g. access to adequate water source)
- Plan to preserve tree plantings into the long-term future

Council staff will then be in contact to discuss your property's suitability and the number of trees that may be planted through the Landowner Program.
