Advent: A Time of Hope and Reflection

This weekend, the First Sunday of Advent, is the beginning of our new Church year. A time of reflection and anticipation. A time of devout and joyful expectation. The word "Advent" comes from the Latin word *adventus*, meaning "coming" or "arrival".

It is sometimes hard to keep in step with the season when we see all the commercial excitement around us so many months before Christmas – Christmas decorations in the stores and sales everywhere. However, in our churches, it is now that we hear and see many things to remind us of the real meaning of this season. The Advent themes (hope, peace, joy and love) unfold over the next four weeks. They invite us to pause and re-direct our focus on God's promises.

Our church environment changes to purple and our Advent wreaths appear. The four Advent Candles, lit one by one each week, mark the four weeks before Christmas - a symbol of our yearning for the Light of Christ. The circle of the wreath, without a beginning and end, symbolises God's unending love for us and reminds us of eternity. The leaves represent growth and hopes for eternal life. This all calls us to expectation and reflection on ourselves.

There was a tendency in the past to consider Advent to be a penitential season like Lent, but the document *General Norms of the Liturgical Year and the Calendar* describes Advent as "a period for devout and joyful expectation" (GNLYC # 39). The Gloria is omitted during Advent, for example, not because it is a season of penance and abstinence, but so that we might sing this hymn, which echoes the song of the angels heralding the birth of Christ, with renewed joy and vigour on Christmas night.

Watching in joyful hope is what the season of Advent is all about. The texts of Advent we hear and pray during mass are some of the richest treasures of the Church's liturgy and can draw us into the true spirit and purpose of the Advent season. I hope this Advent season gives you an opportunity to pause and focus on Jesus more during the lead up to Christmas.

So, I invite you to pray:

Dear Jesus,
you are the hope in our messy world.
This Advent, help us slow down,
listen to your voice,
and focus on what's really important.
We place our hope in you
as we prepare our hearts
to celebrate your birth on Christmas.

Amen.



ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Gospel Meditation



When I was a young priest, about one year after ordination, I was called to the hospital to anoint a dying mother of three young children. She had a painful, terminal cancer. After celebrating Last Rites with her, I said, "Don't be afraid." She looked me square in the eye from her hospital bed and said, "Oh Father, I am in a lot of pain, but I am not afraid. Something wonderful is about to happen." A few days later she died.

Christians face the ending of our personal various "worlds" in a totally unique way. This first Sunday of Advent, Jesus says that when people see their world falling apart, they find themselves "fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world" (Luke 21:26). In our fear, our natural response is to check out, to hide our heads in drunkenness, distraction, and false securities. But Jesus commands us to "look up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." He then compares what's coming to a lovely summer in full bloom. That's what the cross and resurrection empower us to do, as strange as it may seem.

Advent challenge: What world in your life is collapsing? A relationship, a dream, a work opportunity? Maybe you're troubled by a crumbling world in the political or economic sphere. Or maybe someone you love is seriously ill or dying. Name that world or worlds. Then pray: "Lord, help me to not faint with fear. Help me to raise my head and see your redemption coming."
