

Goodwood Road, undertake safety improvements

August 2025

Project overview

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will soon commence construction work to improve safety on Goodwood Road (locally known as Barolin Street) at the Thabeban Street and McCarthy Road intersections in Avenell Heights, along with minor improvements at the Goodwood Road and Coonarr Road intersection.

The project involves:

- installing traffic signals at the Goodwood Road and McCarthy Street intersection
- installing traffic signals at the Goodwood Road and Thabeban Street intersection
- implementing a left turn only into Dunn Road due to its proximity to the proposed traffic signals. Local traffic on Dunn Road will be able to access Goodwood Road via nearby intersections at Sims Road and Avenell Street
- realigning the Thieles Road intersection at Coonarr Road, extra warning signs have already been installed at the Goodwood Road and Coonarr Road intersection.

What to expect

Construction is expected to start in the coming weeks and take about six months to complete, weather permitting.

Works will generally be undertaken from Monday to Friday, 6am to 6pm, though some periodic work outside of these times may be required to complete particular components of the project. During works, nearby businesses and residents may experience the following:

- Disruption to property accesses near the work site, however, access will be maintained under controlled conditions. The project team will minimise access impacts where possible.
- Changed traffic conditions including speed restrictions, lane closures and changed parking arrangements.
- Reversing beepers, flashing lights and lighting towers (where required) will be used during work hours as they are important safety requirements.
- Construction noise and dust may be experienced as heavy machinery will be used during construction. The project team understands the inconvenience this may cause and will reduce impacts where possible.
