



Year 10 Personal Futures Program 2016

Step-by-Step Overview

This week marks the beginning of the Personal Futures Program for Year 10 students to investigate potential career pathways in preparation for senior subject selection. Below is a brief step-by-step guide of this process. More details will be released to students and parents next week.

Date claimer – Senior Subject Selection Information Evening: 7:00pm, Tuesday 26 July.

Step 1. – *Monday 18 July:* Year 10 Students attend Personal Futures Briefing for full overview of program.

Step 2. – **Students and Parents: Preparation for Personal Futures Day:**

During the Personal Futures day, students will be developing a career profile to help give some guidance as to a potential suitable career path. To assist this, a range of actions may be beneficial:

- Talk to your parents about plans for after Year 12 – work, university, gap year, short and longer-term career goals . . .

Step 3. – Students register for Career Information Sessions for Personal Futures Day. By **Wednesday 20 July 2016**, students must have selected the FOUR (4) Career Information Sessions they plan to attend during periods 1 and 2 on Friday 22 July 2016. These selections will be done online and students will be instructed on how to do this at Monday's briefing.

Step 4. – *Friday 22 July:* Personal Futures Day – all day for all Year 10s.

Step 5. – *Tuesday 26 July:* Senior Subject Selection Information Evening – Year 10 students and parents. ***Webchoice Subject Selection Portal (on-line subject selection) opens Tuesday 26 July 2016***

Step 6. – Completion of SET (Senior Education & Training) Plans. SET Plan interviews will be held from *Monday 8 to Friday 19 August*. Appointments will be distributed towards the end of the preceding week. SET Plan interviews are conducted during the regular school day.
