Most examinations will be held in rooms Ad1 to Ad6 and Mc5 to Mc7. The Dance examinations will be held in the Theatre. Actual rooming will be advised in the week prior to the start of the examination block.

Students not involved in examinations will be engaged in home study or study in the Senior covered area. Students may not leave the College grounds between the morning and afternoon sessions.

All students with outstanding assessments (including missed examinations) will be required to complete same during available sessions within the examination block. Class teachers, the House Coordinator and/or the Senior School Coordinator will advise students of these arrangements as necessary.
