Most examinations will be held in rooms **Ad1 to Ad6** and **Mc5 to Mc7**. The Dance and Drama examinations will be held in the Theatre.

Students not involved in examinations will be engaged in home study or study in the Senior covered area. The only other facility at the College that students may avail themselves of during the examination period will be the Beerarlem and the Goondeel libraries. **Access to the libraries can only be gained through prior booking.** In the event of wet weather, classrooms will be made available for study. Students may not leave the College grounds between the morning and afternoon sessions.

Students must wear full day uniform when attending examinations or other activities during the examination period.

Students who expect to be absent for an examination must negotiate alternative arrangements with the Learning Area Coordinator or class teacher. Students who miss an examination must make immediate contact with the House Coordinator.

All students with outstanding assessments (including missed examinations) will be required to complete same during available sessions within the examination block. Class teachers, the House Coordinator and/or the Senior School Coordinator will advise students of these arrangements as necessary.
