Entry guidelines and submission form

- 1. Students will be judged in two separate groups: year 7-9 and year 10-12
- 2. Within each group there will be two categories: poetry and short story
- 3. A winner will be announced from each group and each category
- 4. Year 7-9 theme for both categories is "Heroes and Villains"
- 5. Year 10-12 theme for both categories is "Courage"
- 6. Year 7-9 short story word limit is 400-800 words
- 7. Year 10-12 short story word limit is 80-1200 words
- 8. Students may enter as many times as they wish
- 9. Each entry must be accompanied with a separate entry form
- 10. No student names to be written on entry (apart from entry form)
- 11. Submissions must be received by Friday 26th July (Term 3, Week 1) via hardcopy to the Beerarlem library
- 12. Entries will be judged by a panel of independent members of the community based on creativity and engagement with the theme
