WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE IAES?

In order to receive an IAES, an awardee must:

- 1. be an Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- 2. be graduating Year 12 in 2019;
- 3. be intending to commence tertiary studies in the year following acceptance of the scholarship;
- 4. have achieved an a HA (High Achievement) minimum across all subjects;
- 5. have made a positive and consistent contribution to the school community;
- be enrolled or about to be enrolled, in an undergraduate course at the Queensland University of Technology and/or other university in Brisbane;
- 7. be a minimum of 17 years of age at the time of commencing the scholarship; and
- 8. not be the recipient of another concurrent scholarship award whose purpose is to cover accommodation or living expenses (including accommodation) e.g. Centrelink Relocation Scholarship or Centrelink Residential Costs Option.
