Why become a lifeguard?

Supported by Surf Life Saving Queensland's combined history and world class reputation, our lifeguards acquire a set of skills that will last a lifetime.

The role

A lifeguard is responsible for keeping the public safe in an aquatic environment whether it be in the ocean, pool or a lagoon.

The Selection Criteria

Lifeguarding can be a physically challenging role that requires dedication, fitness and stamina.

A lifeguard must maintain and retain a certain level of fitness to fulfil the physical requirements of the role – this includes regular fitness testing. A lifeguard must also be qualified in First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation and hold a Surf Life Saving bronze medallion or equivalent.

An ocean lifeguard must:

- Complete an 800m pool swim in less than 14 minutes
- Perform a simulated rescue mission (600m swim, 800m run, 600m board paddle, 800m run) in a combined time of less than 28 minutes in the ocean

- Perform a tube rescue 100m out to sea and return
- Perform a board rescue 200m out to sea and return
- Undertake CPR upskilling
- Have Marine / PWC / Driver License / blue card
- Undertake First Aid upskilling including Advanced Emergency Care
- · Pass a theoretical knowledge test
- · Pass a local council by-laws knowledge test
- Pass a marine stinger risk management knowledge and skills test (including stinger drags, identification of marine creatures and first aid procedures) for North Queensland

A lagoon lifeguard must:

- Complete a 400m pool swim in less than 8 minutes
- Perform rescue techniques on patients
- Undertake CPR upskilling
- Undertake First Aid upskilling including Advanced Emergency Care
- · Pass a theoretical knowledge test
- Pass a local council by laws knowledge test
