7.0 LODGEMENT OF APPLICATION

All school approved applications for Early Offer Guarantee can be submitted any time from 3 August 2021. They do not need to be submitted in bulk. Applications received by USC after 15 October 2021 will not be accepted. Ensure all applications are accompanied by a copy of the student's most recent progress report or report card.

Offers to approved applicants will commence on 20 August 2021 and run through until 15 October 2021. No offers will be made during the external exam period. A final round of offers will be made on 19 November 2021.

The Principal (or their delegate) reserves the right to withdraw their recommendation for an EOG offer at any point before the final day of school if the student does not maintain satisfactory academic progress throughout the remainder of Year 12.
