Re: Diocesan Ignite Summer Camp Group 2022

What is Ignite Summer Camp?

Summer Camp is four massive days of fun, friends and getting closer to Jesus! It is about kicking off the year on a massive high with your friends and finding your place within God's love. Summer Camp is run by Ignite Youth from Brisbane and is open to all students who will be high school age (year 7 to 12) in 2022. Details for 2022

Summer Camp is being held at QCCC Mapleton in the Sunshine Coast, which is a wonderful venue. The camp runs from the 13th to the 16th of January, however our group has organised to travel down on the 12th of January and spend an extra night at the campsite, so we are ready to begin the next morning. Our group will have bus transport arranged to leave from Rockhampton, Gladstone & Gin Gin. If there is enough interest from other areas, then it may be possible to make further arrangements so please contact me if transport is an issue.

How to Register

To register with our group, you will need to use the following codes:

For male participants: **rockyboy**

For female participants: **rockygirl**

To register go to <https://app.tickets.org.au/iy/summercamp22>. Enter the code in the coupon code field at the top of the page. Fill out the appropriate registration details which will be *Rockhampton Boys/Girls Ticket*. Then select the 'place order' button at the bottom of the page to complete your order. Last year this event sold out and it is expected to sell out again. **I would strongly recommend registering before the end of November to have the best chance of securing a place.** If you have already registered separately then please contact me and I can still have you included in our group

Cost

Registration with our group is \$310 per person. This cost \$10 more than the regular registration, but this covers transport as well as an extra dinner and night's accommodation. Participants will also need to bring funds with them to be able to purchase meals while travelling to and from the camp.

Last year our diocese took 44 young people who had heaps of fun, made new friends, and learnt more about themselves and the Catholic faith. The camp is very well run by an experienced group of leaders, and I believe it is one of the best Catholic youth programs on offer for high school students.
